At the heart of IJWI lies a commitment to bridge schools and communities. The program beyond extends education walls to facilitate community dialogues, awareness campaians, locally-led and initiatives that address real human rights challenges within rural settings. By empowering community teachers and leaders alike, IJWI paves the for sustainable, way community-driven change.
